

Employee Health Reporting Requirements

(Ohio Administrative Code 3717-1-2.1)

Facility Name _____

Food employees and conditional employees are to report to the person in charge when the employee:

Has any of the following symptoms:

Vomiting	Jaundice (yellowing of skin or whites of eyes)	Exposed lesion with pus that is not properly protected
Diarrhea	Sore throat with fever	

The person in charge will exclude or restrict the employee to reduce the risk of foodborne disease transmission. These all require exclusion except for sore throat and fever which only restricts food service workers from handling food unless they work with a high risk population.

Exclusion = May not come to work

Restriction = May work but not with food or food related equipment

Has an illness diagnosed by a health care provider due to:

Campylobacter	Cryptosporidium	Cyclospora	Entamoeba histolytica
Shiga toxin-producing Escherichia coli (STEC)	Giardia	Hepatitis A	Norovirus
Salmonella spp. or Salmonella typhi	Shigella	Vibrio cholerae	Yersinia

The person in charge is required to contact the Erie County Health Department (419) 626-5623 to report physician diagnosed illnesses listed above to the Environmental Health Division or the Office of Epidemiology and Surveillance.

Is living in the same household as an individual diagnosed with the following illnesses or Has recently been part of a confirmed disease outbreak for the following illnesses:

Norovirus	Shiga toxin-producing Escherichia coli (STEC)	
Hepatitis A	Salmonella Typhi	Shigella spp.

The person in charge is required to contact the Erie County Health Department (419) 626-5623 to report conditions listed above to the Environmental Health Division or the Office of Epidemiology and Surveillance.
