

Level One Food Protection Course Registration

The Ohio Uniform Food Code requires that all food operations have a Person in Charge present during all hours of operation. This person must be able to demonstrate knowledge of safe food handling and sanitation in order to prevent food-borne illnesses. The Erie County Health Department is offering a 3 hour course for a fee of \$30.00 per person. This course will cover all topics related to Person in Charge responsibilities and is recommended for all food service workers. This course is accredited by the Ohio Department of Health and is valid state-wide.
